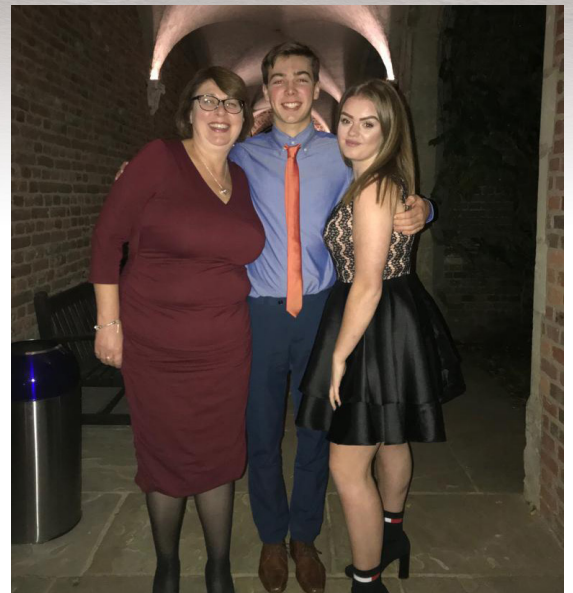
- November Update

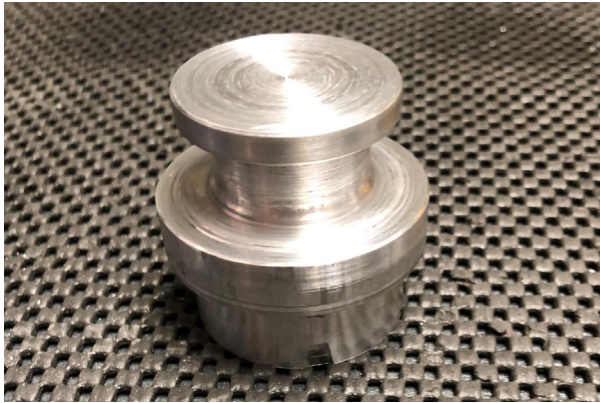
Eastbourne's End of Season Do
